## **DECISION**

The Tribunal unanously accepts that the Claimants were within the seven day time limit as per section 2.2 of the Disputes Resolution Code concerning the Decision of the Sligo County Board of the 12<sup>th</sup> August 2005 received by the Claimants on the 16<sup>th</sup> August 2005. In that they lodged their application on the 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2005 which was amended on the 31<sup>st</sup> August 2005 to include Sligo County Board, which amendment we allow.

Having heard oral submissions, we are satisfied that the County Board properly applied Rule 147(a) of the Official Guide. Therefore, we dismiss this application.

The Tribunal is somewhat concerned that the Claimant did not inform the Tribunal or the Secretary of the DRA of the hearing or the Decision of the Connacht Council of the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2005, which the Claimant attended.
