

DISPUTES RESOLUTION AUTHORITY

In the matter of the Arbitration Act 2010

This case arises from incidents following a Wicklow Minor Football League match between Coolkenno and Newtownmountkennedy, played at Newtown on 21 March 2010.

Following these incidents the Claimant was suspended for a period of 48 weeks pursuant to Rule 7.2. (d)(3) of the official guide 2009. The Claimant contends that there were errors in the manner in which the hearings were conducted.

Prior to the proposed hearing of the DRA on 2 September 2010, the Claimant and Respondants entered into discussions to agree a resolution of the dispute between them and following those discussions the rates agreed to resolve the dispute on the following basis pursuant to paragraph 11.5 of the Dispute Resolution Code

- (1) that the Claimant shall stand suspended for a period of 24 weeks from 10 May 2010 (being the date of the original suspension less agreed credit for suspension served prior to that date) at all codes. The suspension arises pursuant to Rule 7.2(d)(3) "Disruptive Conduct by Team Official, Players or Supporters (not causing the Premature Termination of a Game).
- (2) The costs and expenses of the DRA hearing will be borne as to 60% by the Claimant and 40% by the Respondent.
- (3) The DRA makes no other order as to costs.
